

WELCOME TO ARMORY HOUSE!

What should you bring?

This list has been adapted from University of Illinois Housing. After receiving your room assignment, you will want to contact your roommate and discuss what each of you plan to bring. Decide who will bring large items such as the TV, refrigerator, etc.

Note: Some homeowner's insurance policies do not cover residence hall belongings. Check your policy or consider purchasing renter's insurance for coverage!

What's included in your room?

Armory House provides the following to all residents: Desk chair, one trash can per student, white shower curtain with rod and rings, and plunger. Toilet paper and garbage bags are also supplied weekly to residents.

AH Main Residents: an XL Twin Size bed (height adjustable, with up to 3 feet of space underneath!), mattress pad, desk with bookcase storage and file drawer, and small 3 drawer chest.

AH Suites Residents: a Full Size bed, mattress pad, closet organizer, desk with file drawer for hanging files, and an alcove area with small sink and shelving area

WHAT SHOULD I BRING? Important Documents

- Driver's License or State ID
- Social Security Card (especially if you plan to apply for a job)
- Insurance Information
- Passport and Visa
- ATM Card

Bedding

- Comforter and Blankets
- 1-2 Sets of Sheets
 - **AH MAIN:** TWIN XL SIZED
 - **AH SUITES:** FULL SIZED
- Pillows (including a reading pillow)
- Bedside Caddy

Cleaning and First Aid

- Cleaning Supplies for room: paper towels, all purpose cleaner, etc.
- Thermometer
- First aid kit
- Basic cold medicine & pain killers
- Face Coverings (that cover your nose and mouth)
- Hand Sanitizer

Electronics and School Supplies

- Pens, pencils, & highlighters
- Notebooks, folders, binders, etc.
- Planner
- Backpack
- Computer, Power Cord, Laptop Locking Cable
- TV, Gaming System, Bluetooth Speaker
- Cell Phone and Charger
- Earbuds or Headphones
- **Power Strip with Surge Protector** (with 5-amp resettable circuit breaker; must be UL-approved with a heavy cord and three-prong grounding per city code)

Clothing & Laundry

- Clothing for Warm, Cold & Rainy Weather
- Athletic Clothing, Umbrella and Rainware
- Laundry Basket or Bag
- **HE Laundry Detergent (liquid, powder or pods)**

Bath

- Bath Towels and Washcloths
- Bath Rug
- Bathrobe and Shower Shoes
- Small Caddy
- Toiletries, Hair Dryer and Styling Tools
- Please note-bathrooms will be cleaned weekly by our housekeeping staff!

Storage & Organization

- Hanging Storage Solutions
- Crates or Stacking Containers
- Underbed Storage Organizer
- Hangers
- Shoe Rack/Storage

Room Comfort & Decor

- **Ear plugs or Noise Canceling headbands**-Highly Recommended in a community living environment!
- Room Décor
- Small Nail Picture Hangers
- Carpet or Area Rug
- Non-halogen Desk or Floor Lamp
- Seat Cushion or Your Own Desk Chair
- Poster Putty, Painters Tape, Command Strips for Hanging Up Decorations

Kitchen & Grocery

- Small Microwave, 800 watts or less (one per room)
- Small Refrigerator, no more than 4.4 cubic feet and Energy Star certified (one per room)
- Mug, Drinking Cups, Dishes, Utensils
- Electric Coffee or Tea Maker (with no exposed heating elements)
- Dish Soap and Sponges
- Sealable Storage Containers

Micro Mobility Devices

- Bicycle and strong U-shaped lock
- Skateboard, Longboard, Rollerblades, etc.
- **Please Note: All of the above mentioned devices are NOT allowed to be ridden, operated, or wheeled inside Armory House at any time.**
- Bicycles and scooters must be stored outside on the bike racks or in the AH Suites Garage Basement-space limited, fees apply.
- Smaller, non-powered devices that can be easily carried may be stored in student rooms.

ITEMS TO LEAVE AT HOME

The following items are **NOT** permitted in Armory House:

- Pets
- Wireless Internet Hub
- Halogen Lamps or Halogen Bulbs
- Appliances with exposed heating elements: Hot Plate, Electric Skillet, Toaster, Toaster Oven, George Foreman Grill, etc.
- Candles, Kerosene Heater, Incense, Scent Pot Burners (or other fire hazards)
- Weapons: Air Pellet, Soft Pellet, Water, Paintball or BB Guns; Swords; Knives; Archery Equipment; etc.
- Alcohol (even empty, decorative bottles)
- Oversized Stereo Speakers
- Your Own Mattress or Large Furniture
- Extension Cords
- Large pieces of furniture
- Hoverboards, electric scooters, or other motorized personal transportation devices are strongly discouraged and are not allowed inside Armory House or any UIUC campus buildings. They must be stored outside or in our parking garage-space limited, fees apply.
